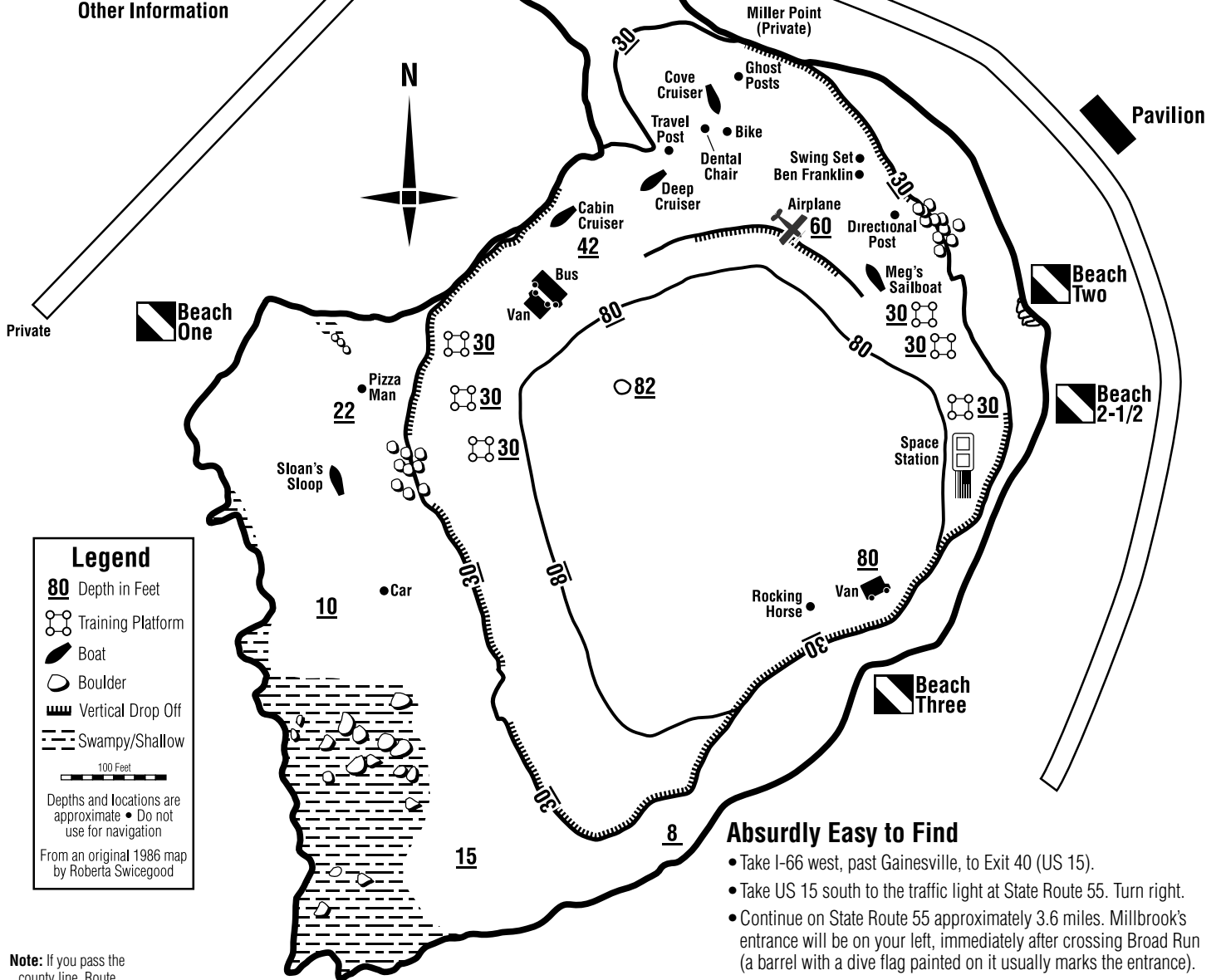

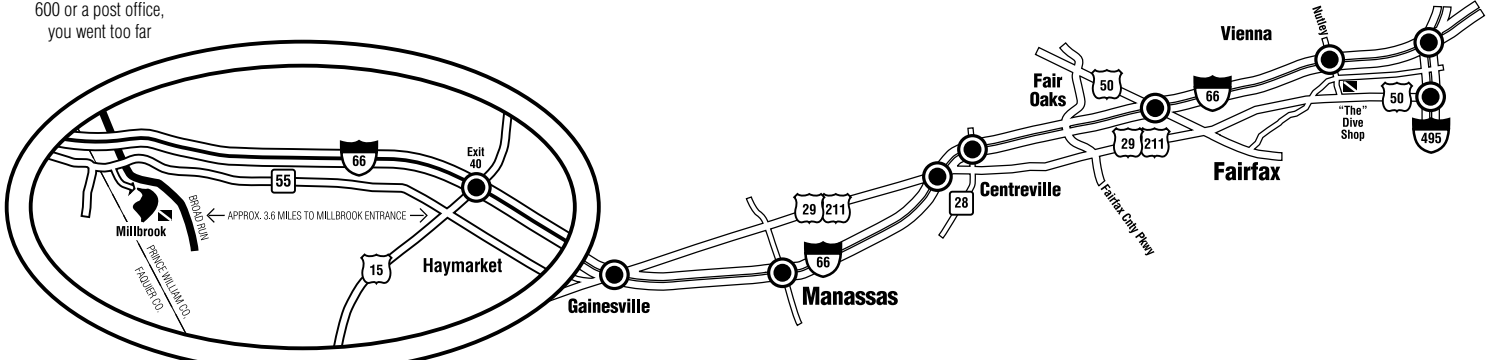

Absurdly Easy to Find

- Take I-66 west, past Gainesville, to Exit 40 (US 15).
- Take US 15 south to the traffic light at State Route 55. Turn right.
- Continue on State Route 55 approximately 3.6 miles. Millbrook's entrance will be on your left, immediately after crossing Broad Run (a barrel with a dive flag painted on it usually marks the entrance).

Note: If you pass the county line, Route 600 or a post office, you went too far



DIVING THE LAKE AT MILLBROOK: IMPORTANT RULES

1. All visitors must stop at the gate when entering.
 - a. *Certified Divers and Continuing Education Students*: Present your admission pass, *completely filled in*, and your certification card. **You will not be let in without a certification card!**
 - b. *Instructors*: Before arriving at Millbrook, *you must have all of the necessary paperwork on file at "The" Dive Shop*, including proof of current liability insurance, proof of teaching/supervisory status with a recognized agency, and sponsoring retail facility affiliation. Upon arriving at Millbrook, present the gatekeeper with your current Millbrook Instructor pass and a list of your students (both entry level and continuing education). Let the attendant know where you will be. We will direct students to you as they arrive. To facilitate this process, please arrive before your students or submit your roster to "The" Dive Shop by close of business Wednesday—otherwise they will have to wait at the gate for your arrival.
 - c. *Assistant Instructors*: You must have an admission pass.
 - d. *Entry-Level Students*: Present your admission pass, *completely filled in*, and tell the gatekeeper who your instructor is. We will direct you to him or her.
2. Drive slowly; raise no dust. *You speed, you leave*—no exceptions. The speed limit is posted: *5 mph*. Divers have the right of way (and may not be able to hear you with hoods on).
3. All in-water activities, whether diving, swimming, or snorkeling, require a *minimum of two participants*. The only exception to this rule exists in the case of certified solo divers who have filled out the necessary liability release and use the equipment required by the standards. You may not solo dive without presenting verification of certification, a completed liability release, and your gear for inspection by the gatekeeper. No solo rebreather diving permitted.
4. Rebreather divers must check in with the gatekeeper and must be certified on the unit they are diving.
5. Divers are expected to *wear and use equipment that meets current standards of practice*, including BCs, pressure gauges, and alternate air sources.
6. *No pets. No fireworks. No exceptions.*
7. *No firearms (except law enforcement).*
8. *No jumping off cliffs, rocks, or barrels* (and no climbing on barrels—okay?). And instructors, please don't bomb the platforms.
9. *No DPVs (scooters). No spear guns.*
10. Respect the rights of others by keeping noise levels to a minimum. *This means no portable air compressors.*
11. Fires are allowed when not in violation of temporary restrictions on open-air burning. *Bring your own firewood, use fire rings, and extinguish your fire completely before leaving.*
12. Admission passes are \$30/person for visitors age 5 and up (\$19/person if purchased beforehand at "The" Dive Shop). Children 4 and under are no charge; however, a responsible adult must still fill out an admission pass on their behalf. *Passes are valid until the last day noted on the pass and are nonrefundable.*
13. Hours of operation: *Anyone on Lake Millbrook grounds after the stated closing time is trespassing on private property.*
 - a. *Saturday*: Normal operating hours are from 8:00 AM until 6:00 PM. No further admission allowed after 4:00 PM. Do not enter the water after 4:30 PM. The gatekeeper reserves the right to close the gates prior to 6:00 PM if there are no divers on the premises.
 - b. *Night Diving – Once a Month*: (5/5, 6/2, 7/7, 8/4, 9/1, 9/29, 10/27). *All night divers (including instructors and students) must be on Lake Millbrook grounds no later than 6:00 PM.* The gate will be closed at 6:00 PM. The gate will reopen from 9:00 PM until 9:30 PM for departing night divers. All divers must be off the premises by 9:30 PM. The gatekeeper reserves the right to close the gates before 6:00 PM if 1) there are no divers on the premises and 2) the gatekeeper has not been informed of any night divers.
 - c. *Saturday Night Camping – Once a Month in June, July, and August*: (6/2, 7/7, 8/4). Camping is \$5/person. The gatekeeper will collect Sunday's admission pass Saturday evening. If you do not have a pass for Sunday, you must pay the \$30 admission fee Saturday night. If you wish to camp, you must be on Lake Millbrook grounds by 5:00 PM. Additional dates may be added at the discretion of "The" Dive Shop. The gatekeeper reserves the right to close the gates before 6:00 PM if 1) there are no divers on the premises and 2) the gatekeeper has not been informed of any campers.
 - d. *Sunday*: Normal operating hours are from 8:00 am until 5:00 PM. No further admission allowed after 3:00 PM. Do not enter the water after 3:30 PM. The gatekeeper reserves the right to close the gates prior to 5:00 PM if there are no divers on the premises.

Divers and/or Instructors who fail to abide by these rules will be required to leave and may be denied re-entry in the future.
